



## Tsai Chin Brings Her “Don’t Say Farewell” World Tour 2026 to Illuminate the Arena of Stars This January

The stage production will complement the emotional richness of her music, incorporating warm lighting, cinematic visuals and an atmosphere created to let her voice shine with clarity and depth. Every detail, from the arrangements to the transitions, is designed to draw the audience back into the moments and memories that her songs once shaped.

Tickets are priced at RM786(VIP), RM636 (PS1), RM496 (PS2), RM356 (PS3), and RM216 (PS4). A processing fee of RM4 applies per ticket. Early bird sales will open on 1 December 2025 at 12pm.
