



Anime Fantasia Brings Airi Suzuki, noa and KLP48 to Arena of Stars for a High-Energy J-Pop Celebration

Genting Highlands, 1 December 2025 – One stage, three stars; a New Year’s night powered by pure J-pop energy. Resorts World Genting is kicking off the 2026 with an electrifying celebration of anime and pop culture as the Anime Fantasia Live at RWG takes over from 29 December 2025 to 3 January 2026.
