



ALL IN and Unstoppable: Shin Sets the Stage Ablaze at the Arena of Stars

Genting Highlands, 14 January 2026 – Rock powerhouse Shin 苏见信（信）is set to bring his highly acclaimed “ALL IN” concert tour to the Arena of Stars on 21 March 2026 at 6pm. Widely regarded as one of Mandopop’s most powerful rock vocalists, Shin first rose to prominence as the frontman of legendary rock band Shin Band (信乐团) before embarking on a successful solo career that has spanned more than two decades. His iconic songs such as “死了都要爱” (Die To Love), “离歌” (Farewell Song), “海阔天空” (Sea & Sky) and “火烧的寂寞” (Burning Loneliness) have become timeless anthems, shaping the soundscape of an entire generation and cementing his legacy as a defining voice in Chinese rock music.

The “ALL IN” concert tour represents a significant milestone in Shin’s career, serving as his first large-scale personal tour in years and a culmination of his musical journey to date. Since its launch, the tour has successfully traveled across multiple cities including Shanghai, Guangzhou, Chengdu, Xiamen, Changchun and Changsha, drawing packed venues and overwhelming audience response. True to its name, “ALL IN” reflects Shin’s personal philosophy of giving everything to every performance, treating each show as a once-in-a-lifetime moment shared with his audience.

Audiences can expect a powerful setlist that blends newly released tracks such as “爱会痛的 忘记不会” (Love Will Hurt, Never Forgotten) and “我对你的爱永垂不朽” (My Love for You Will Never Perish) with re-arranged classics and unforgettable sing-along anthems. The concert showcases Shin’s relentless stamina as he sings from start to finish with a single microphone, delivering soaring high notes, emotionally charged ballads and full-throttle rock performances. The show promises not only musical intensity, but moments of vulnerability, nostalgia and genuine connection that define the “ALL IN” experience.

Tickets are priced at RM882 (VIP), RM782 (PS1), RM682 (PS2), RM482 (PS3), and RM282 (PS4). A processing fee of RM4 applies per ticket. Early bird sales will open on 15 January 2026 at 12pm. During this period, customers can enjoy a 25% discount on tickets for VIP to PS3 categories, while tickets last. After the Early Bird period, Genting Rewards Card members can enjoy an

exclusive 10% discount for VIP to PS3 ticket categories when purchasing with cash, credit card, or Genting Points redemption.

More than just a concert, “ALL IN” is Shin’s declaration of devotion to the stage, to music, and to the fans who have grown alongside him through the years. With unwavering passion and a voice that refuses to fade, Shin continues to prove that rock is not defined by age, but by spirit.
