

## **Resorts World Genting CNY in the Sky: A Season of Elevated Celebrations**

**Genting Highlands, 5 February 2026** – This Chinese New Year, Resorts World Genting welcomes the festive season with the launch of “CNY in the Sky”. ### **1. A Festive Journey Led by Tian Ma, from Screen to Immersive Experience**



Every Chinese New Year begins with a story. This season at Resorts World Genting, that story is led by Tian Ma, the official mascot for the 2026 celebrations and the newest member of the Genting’s Highland Heroes family. Inspired by the Year of the Horse, Tian Ma symbolises movement, progress and fresh beginnings, setting the spirit for the celebrations across the resort.

Guests can experience this festive narrative through the Chinese New Year brand film, which captures familiar moments of reunion, joy and renewal through a warm celebratory lens. The film offers the first glimpse into the season’s atmosphere and can be viewed across Resorts World Genting’s official digital platforms, inviting guests to step into the spirit of CNY in the Sky even before arriving at the resort.

From screen to space, the story continues at the Genting SkyWorlds Immersive Studio where the Chinese New Year themed immersive experience brings the story to life in a visually rich, multi-sensory setting. Surrounded by vivid festive visuals and seasonal storytelling, guests are invited to experience the sights, sounds and emotions of the season from a fresh perspective. The immersive experience runs daily from 9 January to 3 March 2026, with scheduled time slots throughout the day for Genting SkyWorlds Theme Park guests.

Adding to its significance, the Immersive Studio has been officially recognised by the Malaysia Book of Records as the highest-altitude immersive experience in the country, marking a milestone in Resorts World Genting's approach to immersive entertainment and storytelling.



To extend the celebration beyond the experience, guests can also take home a piece of the festivities with limited edition Tian Ma plush toys, available exclusively for Genting Rewards members through redemption and purchase from 29 January to 16 February 2026. Designed as a festive keepsake for the Year of the Horse, the plush toy serves as a cheerful reminder of the season's spirit of movement, progress and new beginnings. Members may choose to redeem the plush toy through the RWG App by deducting 60 Genting Points or by accumulating a total of 6 Genting Points through non-gaming spend during the earning period.

Alternatively, the Tian Ma plush is also available for direct purchase at RM60 per piece. Redemptions are subject to availability and capped per member. Collection for both redemption and purchase is available at the SkyHanger Retail Store at Skytropolis Indoor Theme Park and the Retail Store (Clearance Sale) at Level G, SkyAvenue, allowing guests to conveniently bring home a piece of their Chinese New Year experience at Resorts World Genting.

## 2. Flower Market and Seasonal Shopping Finds



A highlight of the festive season, the Resorts World Genting Flower Market returns to SkyAvenue, transforming the space into a vibrant hub of colour, movement and festive cheer from 15 December 2025 to 16 February 2026. Curated by Flavours of Genting, the market offers a thoughtfully selected range of Chinese New Year essentials, including festive confectionaries, cookies, ready-to-eat favourites, hampers, decorative items and more. Guests can browse a variety of Chinese New Year essentials while soaking in the bustling atmosphere. Complemented by festive retail displays, the market adds to the sense of occasion and offers guests a chance to pick up meaningful items to welcome the new year.

## 3. A Festive Chinese New Year's Eve Countdown Above the Clouds



Taking place on 16 February from 10pm onwards, the Chinese New Year Eve's countdown, Peak Fortune at Arena of Stars sets the tone for the season with a dynamic mix of international, regional and homegrown talent. Hong Kong hip hop duo FAMA brings their signature stage presence to the night while DJ Soda, one of Asia's most

recognisable electronic music acts, takes over the decks as the celebrations build towards midnight. Returning by popular demand, DJ Wukong is back in the house with his high-energy DJ sets, blending pulsating beats with festive flair to keep the momentum soaring as the crowd counts down to the new year. Also taking the stage is Mandopop singer Rong (阿冗) whose heartfelt performances have resonated with audiences across the region. Guiding the evening's festivities are Emcee Royce and Emcee Ding, keeping the crowd engaged as music, lights and performances come together against the cool highland backdrop. The countdown show promises a vibrant spectacle that makes ushering in the Year of the Horse feel truly unforgettable.

The countdown concert is a ticketed event with complimentary admission, offering free seating and standing on a first-come, first-served basis. Ticket redemption begins from 4pm on the event day at the Arena of Stars courtyard and Genting SkyWorlds Theme Park ticketing counters until all tickets are fully redeemed. Guests can gather at the Arena of Stars from 9pm onwards or head to Madison Square to join in on the countdown while enjoying the cool weather.

Guests can also enjoy a seamless countdown experience by dining at selected restaurants across the resort on Chinese New Year Eve, where purchase of the CNY Eve curated menu packages granting complimentary tickets to the Peak Fortune countdown concert (while stocks last).

#### 4. Festive Dining from Pre-Chinese New Year to Reunion Feasts

Food sits at the heart of Chinese New Year at Resorts World Genting, with celebrations beginning early through the Sau Gong and Hoi Gong dinners, marking appreciation, auspicious beginnings and a joyful return to work. The Genting International Convention Centre (GICC) also offers pork-free banquet packages until 31 March, priced from RM2,880 per table of 10, inclusive of a five-room stay at First World Hotel with a minimum booking of five tables.

Festive dining takes centre stage across the resort from 16 February to 3 March, featuring reunion dinners and seasonal feasts at outlets including Old Friends Restaurant, Season, FUHU, and Genting Palace by Crocksfords (Non-Halal), with menus designed for sharing and celebration.

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
No Chinese New Year celebration is complete without tossing for prosperity. Yee Sang is available resort-wide from 16 February to 3 March, with dine-in options across the same participating outlets and takeaway available at selected locations. Guests can choose from a variety of options, including the Golden Vegetarian Yee Sang (RM168 large / RM98 small), featuring a vibrant mix of pomelo, shredded radish, papaya, dried fruits, nuts and plum sauce, as well as classic favourites such as the Lucky Jellyfish Yee Sang, Prosperous Salmon Yee Sang, Prosperity Tuna Yee Sang, and Fortune Fong Sui Abalone Yee Sang, priced from RM198 to RM348 for large portions and RM118 to RM238 for small portions. Custom add-ons are also available, allowing guests to personalise their toss for extra prosperity.

#### **5. 2026 Prosperity Show at Arena of Stars**



On the first two days of Chinese New Year, the Prosperity Show takes centre stage at Arena of Stars, offering multiple sessions (at 3pm, 6pm, and 8pm) that promise a vibrant mix of music, performance and interactive entertainment for the whole family. Guests are treated to dazzling performances, celebrity appearances and thrilling lion dance shows that showcase both skill and tradition. Adding an extra layer of excitement, the show also features a lucky draw at the end of every show time where guests can stand a chance to win an authentic gold coin. Audiences can also participate in photo sessions with the lions, making it a truly immersive experience that combines celebration, entertainment and the joy of giving.

## 6. Festive Decorations and Photo-Worthy Moments Across the Resort



Chinese New Year takes over Resorts World Genting with festive décor zones bursting with colour, lights and playful surprises, transforming every corner of the resort into part of the celebration.


## 7. Try Your Luck with the CNY in the Sky Auspicious Grab & Win





As the season continues, the atmosphere turns especially meaningful on 25 February, when visitors gather after midnight for the Prayer to the God of Heavens (Bai Tian Gong), marked by firecrackers echoing across the highland; a powerful and memorable way to welcome blessings for the year ahead.



With its cool mountain air, glowing lights and steady flow of festive activity, Chin Swee Caves Temple offers a different pace of celebration; one that feels reflective, immersive and deeply woven into the rhythm of Chinese New Year at Resorts World Genting.
