

## Where Music Flows and Emotions Rise: 2026 Ge Bi Lao Fan \_ Fan Kai Jie “Fluidity” Concert at Arena of Stars

**Genting Highlands, 8 April 2026** – Chinese singer-songwriter Fan Kai Jie (樊凯杰), also known as Ge Bi Lao Fan (隔壁老樊), is set to bring his highly anticipated “Fluidity” Concert Tour to the Arena of Stars on 10 October 2026 at 6pm.

From the raw and aching vulnerability of his breakout ballads to the more uplifting reflective tracks that speak of love and quiet resilience, each song carries a piece of lived experience. Performed live, these tracks take on a new dimension, building from life’s fleeting, fragile moments into poetic melodies that linger long after the music ends.

Built around the idea of “Fluidity”, the concert reflects the movement of life itself; constantly shifting, evolving and unfolding in real time. On stage, Fan Kai Jie channels this concept through an unfiltered and deeply expressive performance style, where every lyric, note and pause carries weight. From his early days as an athlete to discovering his passion for music through a guitar, Fan’s journey has been one of transformation and authenticity. His rise from late-night solo performances to sold-out concert halls reflects a path defined not by convention, but by an unwavering commitment to honest storytelling through music.

Having completed multiple successful tours, including the 2023 “Return Journey” Tour, Fan continues to evolve as a live performer. The “Fluidity” concert marks his latest chapter, one that strips away labels and expectations, allowing music to exist in its purest form. It is an invitation to embrace life’s uncertainties, and to find beauty in its ever-changing rhythm.
