

A Night of Memories: Daniel Chan Celebrates 30 Years of Music at Arena of Stars

Genting Highlands, 15 May 2026 – A night built on nostalgia, emotion and timeless Mandopop memories awaits as Hong Kong singer-songwriter Daniel Chan (陈晓东) returns to the stage with the Neon Reflections 30 Concert at the Arena of Stars on 27 June 2026 at 6pm. Marking 30 years in music and entertainment, the concert celebrates Daniel Chan’s enduring journey alongside the fans who have supported him through the decades.

Widely regarded as one of the defining voices of Mandopop from the 90s and 2000s, Daniel Chan rose to fame through a collection of heartfelt ballads that became deeply woven into the memories of a generation. His signature vocals and emotional storytelling established him as a familiar presence across different chapters of life, with songs that continue to resonate long after their release.

Conceived as both a celebration and reunion, Neon Reflections 30 Concert reflects on Daniel Chan’s evolution as an artist over the past three decades while honouring the lasting bond he has built with audiences throughout the years. Returning to the stage with the warmth and sincerity that fans have long connected with, the concert brings together music, emotion and reflection, bringing new life to the melodies that have accompanied listeners through youth, love and adulthood.

Set against the cool highlands atmosphere, the show is designed as an immersive, emotional experience where past and present meet on one stage. With its glowing “neon reflections” theme, the night promises a shared journey through time, featuring a string of his most beloved classics, including “水瓶座” (Aquarius), “心有独钟” (Only One in My Heart), “比我幸福” (Happier Than Me), “吉他” (Guitar) and more. Each performance is expected to bring back waves of nostalgia, reconnecting fans to moments once tied to these songs, from school days and first love to the quieter reflections of adulthood.

Tickets are priced at RM1,088 (VIP), RM888 (PS1), RM688 (PS2), RM488 (PS3), and RM288 (PS4). A processing fee of RM4 applies per ticket. Early bird sales will open on 18 May at 12pm. During this period, customers can enjoy a 25% discount on tickets for VIP to PS3 categories, while tickets last. After the Early Bird period, Genting Rewards Card members can enjoy an exclusive 10% discount for VIP to PS3 ticket categories when purchasing with cash, credit card, or Genting Points redemption.

More than a concert, the night stands as a tribute to three decades of music, emotion and connection. It is a space where past and present meet, where audiences are invited not just to listen, but to feel everything all over again.
