

Voice of National Day: Merdeka Concert Celebrates Home, Identity and Unity at the Arena of Stars

Genting Highlands, 3 July 2026 – In conjunction with the National Day celebrations, Resorts World Genting (RWG) is proud to present Voice of National Day, a special concert that brings together five Malaysian artists from different backgrounds and musical journeys in a heartfelt celebration of identity, unity and home. Taking place at the Arena of Stars on 29 August 2026 at 6pm, the concert invites audiences to experience Malaysia through music, stories and shared memories.

Built around the concept of unity in diversity, the concert presents a musical journey inspired by the many experiences that shape Malaysia. Through the five themed chapters of Departure, Wandering, Awakening, Homecoming and Legacy, Voice of National Day reflects moments of leaving, searching, rediscovering and returning, capturing shared emotions that connect Malaysians across backgrounds, languages and generations.

The line-up brings together Z-Chen, Abin, DannyOne, Amsyar Lee and Boon Yaw, representing different eras and directions within Malaysia's music scene. Renowned Malaysian R&B singer Z-Chen (张智成), whose signature hits including "May I Love You", 凌晨 3 点钟 (3 in the Morning) and 暗恋 (Secret Admirer) have made him one of the most recognisable voices in Mandarin pop music. Joining him is award-winning singer-songwriter Abin (方炯镔), whose emotional ballads such as 坏人 (Bad Guy) and 遗憾 (Regret) have earned widespread acclaim across the Mandopop landscape and numerous industry accolades.

Representing a new generation of Malaysian talent is Amsyar Lee, whose remarkable vocal versatility and viral online performances have rapidly established him as one of the country's most promising young entertainers. Audiences can also look forward to performances by DannyOne (温力铭), the multi-talented singer, songwriter and actor known for blending contemporary pop, hip-hop and distinctly Malaysian influences in his work. Completing the line-up is independent musician, producer and original music advocate Boon Yaw (玟耀), whose contributions to Malaysia's independent music scene have earned recognition both locally and internationally.

Together, the five artists will bring their unique perspectives and musical styles to the stage, creating a concert experience that celebrates the richness of Malaysia's diversity while reminding audiences of the values and experiences that bind them together.

The concert features live performances of reimagined favourites and patriotic classics, supported by immersive staging and large-scale LED visuals inspired by Malaysia's landscapes, cities and cultural heritage. Each segment flows seamlessly into the next, creating a continuous concert experience where music, performance and atmosphere unfold together on stage.

Tickets are priced at RM448 (VIP), RM348 (PS1), RM248 (PS2), and RM148 (PS3). A processing fee of RM4 applies per ticket. Early bird sales will open on 6 July at 12pm. During this period, customers can enjoy a 25% discount on tickets for VIP to PS2 categories, while tickets last. After the Early Bird period, Genting Rewards Card members can enjoy an exclusive 10% discount for VIP to PS2 ticket categories when purchasing with cash, credit card, or Genting Points redemption.

As the evening unfolds, five individual voices will gradually merge into one collective voice, culminating in a powerful tribute to the nation and its people.
