A trip down memory lane as Zhao Chuan returns to the Arena of Stars in January 2023

Genting Highlands, 3 November 2022 - Fans of celebrated Taiwanese pop star, Zhao Chuan are in for a treat as the renowned veteran singer, also known as "Chief" Chao, will be performing live at the Arena of Stars, Resorts World Genting on 7 January 2023 at 8:30pm.

The live concert will be a major highlight for the singer who has spent over 3 decades making his mark in the Asian music circuit through popular hit singles and international performances. Zhao is best known for the monster hit song, I'm Ugly but Gentle which propelled him to instant stardom in Taiwan and Mainland China upon its release in 1988. The album, I'm Just A Little Bird followed in 1990 along with many other successful albums and hit songs such as I've Finally Lost You, How Should I Express My Love To You and The Fool Who Loved You, over the next decades.

Distinguished by his plaintive crystal-clear vocals and heart-felt delivery, Zhao was named *Best Mandarin Male Singer* at the *1991 Golden Melody Awards*. The singer has appeared in popular Chinese musical reality shows - Hunan TV's *I Am A Singer* and Jiangsu TV's *Masked Singer* in recent years. Zhao has also made a Malaysian connection singing *Thank You*, the theme song of the Malaysian Hokkien film, *You Mean The World To Me*, in 2017.

Zhao last performed for fans in 2019 at Zhao Chuan Rose In The Rock Live in Genting. Make a date with Zhao Chuan at his live concert this coming January! Concert-goers can look forward to a nostalgic trip down memory lane as Zhao will be belting out classics such as I'm a Little Bird, I'm Ugly but Gentle and other popular songs from his best-selling albums.
